Rural Mobile Crisis Response Team:

The Rural Mobile Crisis Response Team (RMCRT) supports youth and families, who are experiencing a behavioral crisis, find community services across Rural and Frontier Nevada. The services are designed to reduce emergency department visits due to a psychiatric crisis and to reduce psychiatric hospitalizations when appropriate by providing immediate support and crisis interventions, short-term stabilization and case management services. Interventions are provided in the community, home, and/or through phone/video consultation.

Goals and Values:

- Support and maintain youth in their home and community environment.
- Provide a thorough diagnostic assessment completed by a mental health professional.
- Facilitate short term in-patient psychiatric hospitalization when needed.
- Assist youth and families in accessing and linking to on-going support and services.
- Respond immediately to children and families during times of behavioral/mental health crisis.
- Reduce emergency department visits for psychiatric crisis by providing immediate response to youth exhibiting behavioral/mental health crisis.
- Provide services that are family-driven, culturally competent, community based and consistent with Nevada System of Care principles.
- Assure safety and continuity of care through individualized strategies implemented by a wraparound-based, team approach.
