5. PRINCIPALS' REPORTS--

Neil Gallagher- Nothing to report other than written report.
Pershing County High School Principal Johnathan Reynolds mentioned PCHS graduation is changing to keep with social distance requirement. Individual graduations for each 40 graduates starting June 1st and 2nd from 8:00 am – 1:00 pm on each day, to take place in the High School Foyer.

After the ceremonies there will be a parade through town.
US Silica donated banners for each graduate for parade.

Mrs. Nee will be compiling flash drives for each senior with class presentation. Principal Reynolds will get schedule ready and Superintendent Fecht will work with Board Members to ensure one board member is there to present diplomas.

Principal Reynolds described what his staff is doing to encourage students to get work done and how the staff are going above and beyond to reach out to students to make sure they have as much support as possible.

Board Member Cindy Plummer asked Alternative Education Director, Neil Gallagher if there will be an adult high school graduation this year. Director Gallagher explained they were looking at something more private at Learning Center with family members of graduates but they have not decided anything yet.

Superintendent Fecht stated Kindergarten Graduation will be similar to high school. There will be a controlled time for kindergarten graduates with opportunities for pictures and an opportunity for parents and teachers to wrap up the year.

Negotiations have been done with support staff and certified staff.
No new information about fiscal impact from COVID-19.

Staff is staying busy with multiple projects. Foodservice is serving meals until June 4th.

Staff are finding ways to get packets to students.

Board Member Cindy Plummer asked if there will be a meeting in July. Superintendent Fecht said he does not foresee a reason to have a meeting but if one is needed, there will be one.

Board Member Walter Brinkerhoff asked about school closures. Superintendent Fecht stated they will have a check-in/check-out process at Pershing County High School and Pershing County Middle School. Lovelock Elementary School has bagged up all personal belongings and each grade will have a table with drive by pick up. Every student will have access to MYON Reader online library until December. Board Member Walter Brinkerhoff asked if this situation has affected our enrollment. Superintendent Fecht answered that the District gained more kids than it lost.
